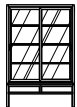
This museum cabinet for private collections is one of the most iconic examples of Time & Style's craftsmanship. It has been specially produced with Japanese keyaki (zelkova) wood for Noma Kyoto. The zelkova is a broadleaf tree that is emblematic of Japan. The distinctive grain and color of the zelkova wood covering the four sides of the cabinet give it an unprecedentedly powerful presence.

Zelkova has been used in Japanese architecture and furniture for centuries. However, working with this wood is challenging due to its tendency to warp and resistance to processing. The cabinet is assembled with intricate joinery techniques by highly skilled artisans who masterfully handle this challenging material.

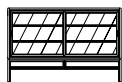

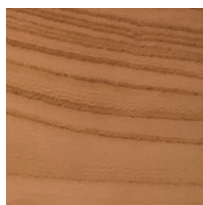
