



Museum cabinet for tableware

Designed as a contemporary reinterpretation of the traditional kitchen cabinet, it combines glass doors in the upper section with wooden doors below. The sliding doors ensure practicality, making it easy to use even in compact kitchen or dining areas where space is limited. The upper section, with its glass doors, serves as both storage and display, offering a refined setting for tableware, books, or cherished objects. Discreet drawers also provide convenient space for cutlery and small essentials.

The lower section, enclosed by wooden doors, offers concealed storage, perfect for organizing pantry staples, cookware, or other household necessities.

In cafés and retail spaces, the ability to close the doors ensures a neat and sophisticated appearance, maintaining a sense of order and elegance.


